### COID STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH- APRIL 1, 1949

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 25,070,000 lb, on April 1, of which 23.3 million lb. were frozen fresh and 1.8 million lb, frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 420,000 lb. frozen fresh and 60,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 2,448,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 863,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at April 1, 1948. Compared with March 1, 1949 figures they are lower by 2,850,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 119,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "out-of-storage" movement for all classifications of 2.7 million 1b. as compared with an opposite movement of 4.8 million 1b. during March 1948.

SEA FISH - COD

Holdings of frozen cod were 3,115,000 lb. not including estimates, consisting of 1,992,000 lb. frozen fresh and 1,123,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during March was 568,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 99,000 lb. during March 1948. The quantity reported as having been frozen during March was 2,188,000 lb. but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock totalled 676,000 lb, not including estimates for late firms, of which 377,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 299,000 1b. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 344,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year and 532,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 602,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during March.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at April 1 were 3,858,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 5,446,000 lb. last year and 5,607,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during March was 1.7 million 1b. as compared with an opposite movement of 3.7 million 1b. during the same month in 1948. Freezings during March were 64,000 1b.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of horring, including kippers reported were 6,473,000 lb., being fresh 6,298,000 lb. and smoked 1.75,000 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 6,826,000 lb. This month's figures show an increase of 82,000 lb. over last month's holdings. The quantity frozen during March was 170,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH Other frozen stocks amounted to 2,923,000 lb., being reported as frozen fresh 2,837,000 lb. and frozen smoked 91,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during March were 431,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 7,535,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 5.000 lb. frozen smoked. There were also 104,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during March.
