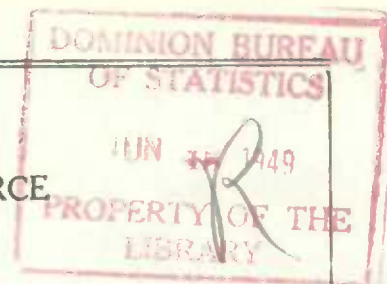

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH -- JUNE 1, 1949

ALL FISH Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 33,523,000 lb. on June 1, of which 30.9 million pounds were frozen fresh and 2.6 million pounds frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 1,190,000 lb. frozen fresh and 325,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 2,646,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 1,201,000 lb. frozen smoked, than those at June 1, 1948. Compared with May 1, 1949 figures they are higher by 10,882,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 324,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 11.2 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 1.4 million pounds during May 1948.

SEA FISH - COD Stocks of frozen cod were 5,186,000 lb. not including estimates, consisting of 3,421,000 lb. frozen fresh and 1,765,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net increase during May was 842,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1.4 million pounds during May 1948. The quantity reported as having been frozen during May was 2,614,000 lb. but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK Stocks of frozen haddock totalled 1,093,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, of which 815,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 278,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 241,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year and 73,000 lb. higher than last month. There were 399,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during May.

SALMON Frozen salmon stocks at June 1 were 2,386,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 2,942,000 lb. last year and 3,029,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during May was 643,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 632,000 lb. during the same month in 1948. Freezings during May were 251,000 lb.

SEA HERRING Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers reported were 7,181,000 lb. being fresh, 7,070,000 lb. and smoked 111,000 lb. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 9,019,000 lb. This month's figure shows an increase of 2,522,000 lb. over last month's holdings. The quantity frozen during May was 3,921,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH Other frozen stocks amounted to 10,217,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 10,134,000 lb. and frozen smoked 83,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during May was 8,580,000 lb.

INLAND FISH There were on hand 5,942,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 3,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were also 41,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during May.
