



COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - AUGUST 1, 1949

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 46,423,000 lb. on August 1 of which 43,167,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 3,256,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 4,938,000 lb. frozen fresh and 450,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 7,843,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 526,000 lb. frozen smoked, than those at August 1, 1948. Compared with July 1, 1949 figures they are higher by 6,102,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 371,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 6.4 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 3.4 million pounds during July 1948.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod were 5,918,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, consisting of 4,048,000 lb. frozen fresh and 1,870,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during July was 538,000 lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 208,000 lb. during July 1948. The quantity reported as having been frozen during July was 2,369,000 lb. but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock totalled 1,254,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, of which 919,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 335,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 927,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year, and 403,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 260,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during July.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at August 1 were 4,084,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 4,169,000 lb. last year and 3,100,000 lb. last month. The apparent net increase during July was 984,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1,290,000 lb. during the same month in 1948. Freezings during July were 2,542,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers, reported were 8,160,000 lb. of which 7,718,000 lb. were fresh and 442,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 7,100,000 lb. This month's figure show an increase of 1,669,000 lb. from last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during July was 2,810,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 16,220,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 16,129,000 lb. and frozen smoked 91,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during July was 4,122,000 lb.

INLAND

There were on hand 5,372,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 27,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 719,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during July.
