# COID STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - OCTOBER 1, 1950

## ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 56,968,000 lb. on October 1, 1950 of which 53,591,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 3,377,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 605,000 lb. frozen fresh and 22,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 4,603,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 222,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at October 1, 1949. Compared with September 1, 1950 figures they are higher by 2,301,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 392,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 1.8 million pounds as compared with an opposite movement of 2.1 million pounds during September 1949.

## SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod were 9,056,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms consisting of 7,234,000 lb. frozen fresh and 1,822,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during September was 1,683,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 364,000 lb. during September 1949. The quantity reported as having been frozen during September was 4,296,000 lb. but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

#### HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock totalled 964,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, of which 741,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 223,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 562,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year, and 515,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 462,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during September 1950.

#### SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at October 1 were 12,980,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 9,392,000 lb. last year and 7,155,000 lb. last month. The apparent net increase during September was 5,825,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1,961,000 lb. during the same month in 1949. Freezings during September were 8,690,000 lb.

### SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers were reported as being 13,255,000 lb. of which 12,290,000 lb. were fresh and 965,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 12,643,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 683,000 lb. from last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during September was 1,420,000 lb.

#### OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 15,715,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 15,499,000 lb. and frozen smoked 216,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during September was 3,230,000 lb.

## INLAND FISH

There were on hand 4,267,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 104,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 810,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during September 1950.
