COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH-NOVEMBER 1, 1950

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 61,213,000 lb. on November 1, 1950 of which 57,963,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 3,260,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 2,110,000 lb. frozen fresh and 105,000 lb. frozen smoked are included fir firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 4,000,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 255,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at November 1, 1949. Compared with October 1, 1950 figures they are higher by 4,277,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 135,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 4.1 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 4.8 million pounds during October 1949.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod were 8,955,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms consisting of 7,270,000 lb. frozen fresh and 1,685,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during October was 315,000 lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 1,126,000 lb. during October 1949. The quantity reported as having been frozen during October was 3,185,000 lb. but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDO CK

Stocks of frozen haddock totalled 1,045,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, of which 836,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 209,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 258,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year, and 64,000 lb. higher than last month. There were 582,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during October 1950.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at November 1 were 16,707,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 15,065,000 lb. last year and 13,022,000 lb. last month. The apparent net increase during October was 3,685,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 5,673,000 lb. during the same month in 1949. Freezings during October were 7,160,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers were reported as being 11,331,000 lb. of which 10,469,000 lb. were fresh and 862,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 9,870,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 2,223,000 lb. from last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during October was 213,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 15,012,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 14,755,000 lb. and frozen smoked 257,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during October was 3,250,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 5,852,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 96,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 1,809,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during October 1950.
