COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH- DECEMBER 1. 1950

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 54,723,000 lb. on December 1, 1950 of which 51,864,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 2,859,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 725,000 lb. frozen fresh and 48,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 5,360,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 395,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at December 1, 1949. Compared with November 1, 1950 figures they are lower by 6,347,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 380,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "out-of-storage" movement for all classifications of 6.7 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 8.0 million pounds during November 1949.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod were 9,301,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms consisting of 7,690,000 lb. frozen fresh and 1,611,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net increase during November was 90,000 lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 648,000 lb. during November 1949. The quantity reported as having been frozen during November was 3,636,000 lb. but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock totalled 1,316,000 lb. but not including estimates for late firms, of which 1,052,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 264,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 47,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year, and 168,000 lb. higher than last month. There were 641,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during November 1950.

SALMON Frozen salmon stocks at December 1 were 14,357,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 11,614,000 lb. last year and 16,828,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during November was 2,471,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 3,451,000 lb. during the same month in 1949. Freezings during November were 710,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers were reported as being 10,352,000 lb. of which 9,576,000 lb. were fresh and 776,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 8,880,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 1,973,000 lb. from last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during November was 360,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 14,181,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 14,102,000 lb. and frozen smoked 79,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during November was 3,708,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 4,377,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 66,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 316,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during November 1950.
