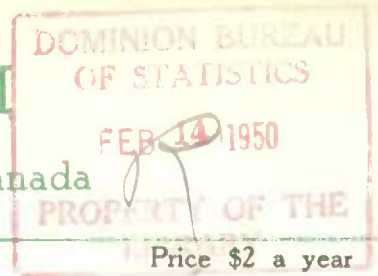

## COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH- FEBRUARY 1, 1950

### ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 31,741,000 lb. on February 1, 1950 of which 29,865,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 1,876,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 271,000 lb. frozen fresh and 20,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are lower by 337,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 206,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at February 1, 1949. Compared with January 1, 1950 figures they are lower by 7,129,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 388,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "out-of-storage" movement for all classifications of 7.5 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 5.3 million pounds during January 1949.

### SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod were 5,193,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, consisting of 4,502,000 lb. frozen fresh and 691,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during January was 1,814,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1,736,000 lb. during January 1949. The quantity reported as having been frozen during January was 592,000 lb. but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

### HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock totalled 986,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, of which 759,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 227,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 462,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year, and 103,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 507,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during January 1950.

### SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at February 1, were 8,174,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 7,811,000 lb. last year and 9,581,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during January was 1,407,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1,517,000 lb. during the same month in 1949. Freezings during January were 14,000 lb.

### SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers were reported as being 6,984,000 lb. of which 6,204,000 lb. were fresh and 780,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 4,985,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 631,000 lb. from last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during January was 687,000 lb.

### OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 7,226,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 7,155,000 lb. and frozen smoked 71,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during January was 208,000 lb.

### INLAND FISH

There were on hand 2,844,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 43,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 197,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during January 1950.

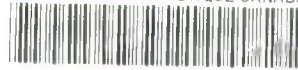
