## COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - MARCH 1, 1950

### ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 25,236,000 lb. on March 1, 1950 of which 23,682,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 1,554,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 216,000 lb. frozen fresh and 20,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are lower by 3,369,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 124,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at March 1, 1949. Compared with February 1, 1950 figures they are lower by 6,330,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 328,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "out-of-storage" movement for all classifications of 6.7 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 3.6 million pounds during February 1949.

### SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod were 3,757,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, consisting of 3,249,000 lb. frozen fresh and 508,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during February was 1,490,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 2,019,000 lb. during February 1949. The quantity reported as having been frozen during February was 599,000 lb. but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

### HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock totalled 778,000 lb., not including estimates for late firms, of which 491,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 287,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 432,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year, and 256,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 1,140,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during February 1950.

### SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at March 1, were 5,985,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 5,607,000 lb. last year and 8,241,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during February was 2,256,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 2,204,000 lb. during the same month in 1949. Freezings during February were 22,000 lb.

### SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers were reported as being 7,178,000 lb. of which 6,549,000 lb. were fresh and 629,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 7,235,000 lb. This month's figures show an increase of 128,000 lb. over last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during February was 1,008,000 lb.

### OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 4,799,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 4,747,000 lb. and frozen smoked 52,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during February was 191,000 lb.

### INLAND FISH

There were on hand 2,465,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 38,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 166,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during February 1950.
