COID STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - JUNE 1, 1950

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 31,680,000 lb.
on June 1, 1950 of which 29,749,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 1,931,000 lb.
frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 360,000 lb. frozen fresh and 35,000 lb.
frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are lower by 10,148,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 647,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at June 1, 1949. Compared with May 1, 1950 figures they are higher by 13,009,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 87,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement "for all classifications of 13.1 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 14.9 million pounds during May 1949.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod were 6,171,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, consisting of 4,801,000 lb. frozen fresh and 1,370,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net increase during May was 986,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1.8 million pounds during May 1949. The quantity reported as having been frozen during May was 4,154,000 lb. but no estimates are made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock totalled 1,006,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, of which 877,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 129,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 1,488,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year, and 114,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 773,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during May 1950.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at June 1, were 2,170,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 2,665,000 lb. last year and 2,932,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during May was 762,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 368,000 lb. during the same month in 1949. Freezings during May were 253,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers were reported as being 10,152,000 lb. of which 9,872,000 lb. were fresh and 280,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 11,973,000 lb. This month's figures show an increase of 4,509,000 lb. from last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during May was 7,808,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 10,207,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 10,162,000 lb. and frozen smoked 45,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during May was 10,895,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 1,537,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 42,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 22,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during May 1950.
