COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - JULY 1, 1950

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 40,089,000 lb. on July 1, 1950 of which 37,382,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 2,707,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 380,000 lb. frozen fresh and 30,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are lower by 5,734,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 186,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at July 1, 1949. Compared with June 1, 1950 figures they are higher by 7,734,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 776,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 3.5 million pounds as commared with a similar movement of 3.5 million pounds during June 1949.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod were 7,094,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, consisting of 5,091,000 lb. frozen fresh and 2,003,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net increase during June was 864,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1.1 million pounds during June 1949. The quantity reported as having been frozen during June was 4,506,000 lb. but no estimates are made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock totalled 882,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, of which 686,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 196,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 1,546,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year, and 133,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 1,541,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during June 1950.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at July 1, were 2,486,000 1b. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 3,376,000 1b. last year and 2,216,000 1b. last month. The apparent net increase during June was 270,000 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 711,000 1b. during the same month in 1949. Freezings during June were 1,229,000 1b.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers were reported as being 10,503,000 lb. of which 10,140,000 lb. were fresh and 363,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 8,697,000 lb. This month's figures show an increase of 233,000 lb. over last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during June was 3,457,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 16,861,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 16,811,000 lb. and frozen smoked 50,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during June was 10,172,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 1,821,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh during June 1950.
