## COID STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH- AUGUST 1, 1950

### ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 49,440,000 lb. on August 1, 1950 of which 45,209,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 3,231,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 2,536,000 lb. frozen fresh and 34,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are lower by 4,213,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 49,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at August 1, 1949. Compared with July 1, 1950 figures they are higher by 7,402,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 475,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 7.9 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 6.9 million pounds during July 1949.

#### SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod were 9,881,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, consisting of 7,796,600 lb. frozen fresh and 2,085,600 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net increase during July was 2,503,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 587,000 lb. during July 1949. The quantity reported as having been frozen during July was 6,034,000 lb. but no estimates are made for firms failing to report on time.

#### HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock total led 1,335,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, of which 1,089,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 246,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 829,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year, and 482,000 lb. higher than last month. There were 1,232,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during July 1950.

# SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at August 1 were 3,107,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 4,836,000 lb. last year and 2,550,000 lb. last month. The apparent net increase during July was 557,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1,460,000 lb. during the same month in 1949. Freezings during July were 2,404,000 lb.

#### SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers were reported as being 11,445,000 lb. of which 10,793,000 lb. were fresh and 652,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 11,316,000 lb. This month's figures show an increase of 796,000 lb. over last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during July was 2,709,000 lb.

#### OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 16,985,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 16,884,000 lb. and frozen smoked 101,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during July was 4,911,000 lb.

#### INLAND FISH

There were on hand 3,036,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 31,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 1,023,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during July 1950.
