COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FIGH - SEPTEMBER 1, 1950

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 53,860,000 lb. on September 1, 1950 of which 50,086,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 3,774,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 2,248,000 lb. frozen fresh and 100,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are lower by 698,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 278,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at Sept. 1, 1949. Compared with August 1, 1950 figures they are higher by 4,838,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 494,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement" for all classifications of 5.3 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 1.7 million pounds during August 1949.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod were 10,282,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, consisting of 8,041,000 lb. frozen fresh and 2,241,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during August was 10,000 lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 188,000 lb.during August 1949. The quantity reported as having been frozen during August was 4,481,000 lb. but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDO CK

Stocks of frozen haddock totalled 1,453,000 lb. not including estimates for late firms, of which 1,229,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 224,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 661,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year, and 55,000 lb. higher than last month. There were 1,101,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during August 1950.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at September 1 were 6,219,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 7,431,000 lb. last year and 3,392,000 lb. last month. The apparent net increase during August was 2,827,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 2,595,000 lb. during the same month in 1949. Freezings during August were 4,685,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers were reported as being 12,344,000 lb. of which 11,430,000 lb. were fresh and 914,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 12,820,000 lb. This month's figures show an increase of 360,000 lb. over last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during August was 2,429,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 17,160,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 16,975,000 lb. and frozen smoked 185,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during August was 3,373,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 3,966,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 88,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 989,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during August 1950.
