#### COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - JANUARY 1, 1951

#### ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 45,890,000 lb. on January 1, 1951 of which 43,336,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 2,554,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 519,000 lb. frozen fresh and 20,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 4,116,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 278,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at January 1, 1950. Compared with December 1, 1950 figures they are lower by 8,744,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 291,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "Out-of-storage" movement for all classifications of 9.0 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 7.5 million pounds during December 1949.

#### SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 6,456,000 lb. consisting of 5,094,000 lb. frozen fresh and 1,362,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during December was 2,678,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 955,000 lb. during December 1949. The quantity reported as having been frozen during December was 1,282,000 lb. but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

#### HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock, not including estimates for late firms, totalled 1,234,000 lb. of which 975,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 259,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 149,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year and 119,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 361,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during December 1950.

#### SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at January 1 were 11,983,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 9,627,000 lb. last year and 14,425,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during December was 2,442,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1,987,000 lb. during the same month in 1949. Freezings during December were 20,000 lb.

#### SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers were reported as being 10,290,000 lb. of which 9,542,000 were fresh and 748,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 8,148,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 758,000 lb. from last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during December was 1,407,000 lb.

#### OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 12,136,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 12,038,000 lb. and frozen smoked 98,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during December was 2,052,000 lb.

#### INLAND FISH

There were on hand 3,206,000 lb of inland fish frozen fresh and 46,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 162,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during December 1950.
