COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - DECEMBER 1, 1951

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 50,200,000 lb. on December 1, 1951, of which 47,986,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 2,214,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 1,385,000 lb. frozen fresh and 60,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are lower by 6,565,000 lb. frozen fresh, and by 629,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at November 1, 1951. Compared with December 1, 1950, figures they are lower by 4,088,000 lb. frozen fresh and 676,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "out-of-storage" movement for all classifications of 7.2 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 6.4 million pounds during November, 1950.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 6,062,000 lb., consisting of 4,851,000 lb. frozen fresh and 1,211,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during November was 797,000 lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 10,000 during November, 1950. The quantity reported as having been frozen during November was 2,358,000 lb., but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock, not including estimates for late firms, totalled 1,632,000 lb. of which 1,398,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 234,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 232,000 lb. higher than the stocks on hand last year, but 328,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 559,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during November, 1951.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at December 1 were 13,750,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 14,430,000 lb. last year and 15,448,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during November was 1.7 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 2.4 million pounds during the same month of 1950. Freezings during November were 1,322,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers, were reported as being 6,043,000 lb. of which 5,443,000 lb. were fresh and 600,000 smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 10,878,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 1.3 million pounds from last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during November was 448,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 15,877,000 lb., being reported as frozen fresh, 15,803,000 lb. and frozen smoked, 74,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during November totalled 2,667,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 5,381,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 10,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 121,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during the month of November, 1951.
