COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - MARCH 1, 1951

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 32,248,000 lb. on March 1, 1951 of which 30,089,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 2,159,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 2,760,000 lb. frozen fresh and 180,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are lower by 6,398,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 367,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at February 1, 1951. Compared with March 1, 1950 figures they are higher by 4,152,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 541,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "out-of-storage" movement for all classifications of 6.8 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 6.5 million pounds during February 1950.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 3,396,000 lb. consisting of 2,241,000 lb. frozen fresh and 1,155,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during February was 1.8 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 1.4 million pounds during February 1950. The quantity reported as having been frozen during February was 2,721,000 lb. but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock, not including estimates for late firms, totalled 1,072,000 lb. of which 850,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 222,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 690,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year and 312,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 775,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during February 1951.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at March 1 were 6,387,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 6,074,000 lb. last year and 10,411,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during February was 4.0 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 2.2 million pounds during the same month in 1950. Free zings during February were 28,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers were reported as being 8,466,000 lb. of which 8,069,000 lb. were fresh and 397,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 7,517,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 1.2 million pounds from last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during February was 859,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 7,535,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 7,353,000 lb. and frozen smoked 182,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during February was 1,537,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 2,447,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 5,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 196,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during February 1951.
