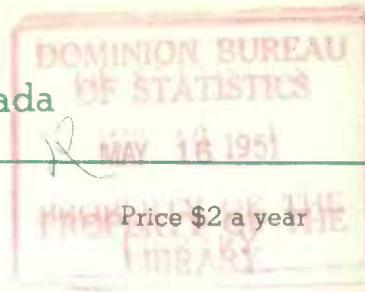

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - MAY 1, 1951

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 25,497,000 lb. on May 1, 1951 of which 22,712,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 2,785,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 1,085,000 lb. frozen fresh and 47,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are lower by 554,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 708,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at April 1, 1951. Compared with May 1, 1950 figures they are higher by 5,891,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 926,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 154,000 pounds as compared with a similar movement of 1.4 million pounds during April, 1950.

SEA-FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 4,332,000 lb. consisting of 2,315,000 lb. frozen fresh and 2,017,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net increase during April was 569,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1.6 million pounds during April, 1950. The quantity reported as having been frozen during April was 4,130,000 lb., but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock, not including estimates for late firms totalled 1,812,000 lb. of which 1,456,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 356,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 690,000 lb. higher than the stocks on hand last year and 313,000 lb. higher than last month. There were 1,620,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during April, 1951.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at May 1 were 4,006,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 2,938,000 lb. last year and 5,035,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during April was 1.0 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 1.2 million pounds during the same month in 1950. Freezings during April were 19,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers were reported as being 7,476,000 lb. of which 7,213,000 lb. were fresh and 263,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 5,644,000 lb. This month's figures show an increase of 56,000 lb. from last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during April was 1,869,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 4,669,000 lb., being reported as frozen fresh 4,593,000 lb. and frozen smoked 76,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during April was 1,330,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 2,063,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 7,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 54,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during April, 1951.
