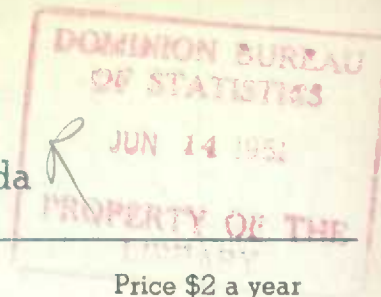

## COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - JUNE 1, 1951

### ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 35,480,000 lb. on June 1, 1951, of which 32,401,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 3,079,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 1,470,000 lb. frozen fresh and 95,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 9,947,000 lb. frozen fresh and by 291,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at May 1, 1951. Compared with June 1, 1950 figures they are higher by 1,363,000 lb. frozen fresh and by 1,120,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 10.2 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 14.3 million pounds during May, 1950.

### SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 4,991,000 lb. consisting of 2,659,000 lb. frozen fresh and 2,332,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net increase during May was 528,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1.1 million pounds during May, 1950. The quantity reported as having been frozen during May was 3,631,000 lb., but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

### HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock, not including estimates for late firms totalled 1,782,000 lb. of which 1,420,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 362,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 761,000 lb. higher than the stocks on hand last year and 42,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 868,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during May, 1951.

### SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at June 1 were 2,408,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 2,223,000 lb. last year and 4,033,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during May was 1.6 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 715,000 lb. during the same month of 1950. Freezings during May were 225,000 lb.

### SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers, were reported as being 8,477,000 lb. of which 8,247,000 lb. were fresh and 230,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 12,367,000 lb. This month's figures show an increase of 404,000 lb. from last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during May was 5,047,000 lb.

### OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 14,451,000 lb., being reported as frozen fresh 14,408,000 lb. and frozen smoked 43,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during May was 12,681,000 lb.

### INLAND FISH

There were on hand 1,804,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 2,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 32,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during May, 1951.
