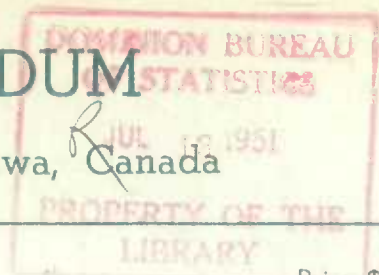

## COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - JULY 1, 1951

### ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 37,992,000 lb. on July 1, 1951, of which 34,914,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 3,078,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 750,000 lb. frozen fresh and 90,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 2,225,000 lb. frozen fresh and by 55,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at June 1, 1951. Compared with July 1, 1950 figures they are lower by 3,928,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 315,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 2.3 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 8.6 million pounds during June, 1950.

### SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 5,491,000 lb., consisting of 3,284,000 lb. frozen fresh and 2,207,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net increase during June was 379,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1.0 million pounds during June, 1950. The quantity reported as having been frozen during June was 3,680,000 lb., but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

### HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock, not including estimates for late firms totalled 2,012,000 lb. of which 1,661,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 351,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 1,076,000 lb. higher than the stocks on hand last year and 160,000 lb. higher than last month. There were 874,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during June, 1951.

### SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at July 1 were 2,559,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 2,560,000 lb. last year and 2,540,000 lb. last month. The apparent net increase during June was 19,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 337,000 lb. during the same month of 1950. Freezings during June were 1,069,000 lb.

### SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers, were reported as being 6,419,000 lb., of which 6,133,000 lb. were fresh and 286,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 12,343,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 2,648,000 lb. from last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during June was 847,000 lb.

### OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 17,590,000 lb., being reported as frozen fresh 17,537,000 lb. and frozen smoked 53,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during June totalled 8,095,000 lb.

### INLAND FISH

There were on hand 3,065,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 16,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 1,348,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during June, 1951.
