COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - SEPTEMBER 1, 1951

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 48,806,000 lb. on September 1, 1951, of which 45,083,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 3,723,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 530,000 lb. frozen fresh and 70,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 5,276,000 lb. frozen fresh and by 298,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at August 1, 1951. Compared with September 1, 1950 figures they are lower by 6,876,000 lb. frozen fresh and by 125,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 5.6 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 6.5 million pounds during August, 1950.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 8,191,000 lb., consisting of 6,031,000 lb. frozen fresh and 2,160,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net increase during August was 1.0 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 465,000 pounds during August, 1950. The quantity reported as having been frozen during August was 4,914,000 lb., but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock, not including estimates for late firms, totalled 2,275,000 lb. of which 1,998,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 277,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 794,000 lb. higher than the stocks on hand last year and 76,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 541,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during August, 1951.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at September 1 were 6,876,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 7,179,000 lb. last year and 4,321,000 lb. last month. The apparent net increase during August was 2.6 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 3.6 million pounds during the same month of 1950. Freezings during August were 3,815,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers, were reported as being 7,511,000 lb. of which 6,450,000 lb. were fresh and 1,061,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 13,970,000 lb. This month's figures show an increase of 681,000 lb. over last month's stocks. The quantity frozen during August was 2,691,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 18,744,000 lb., being reported as frozen fresh, 16,631,000 lb. and frozen smoked, 113,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during August totalled 4,212,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 4,577,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 32,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 513,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during August, 1951.
