



## COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - NOVEMBER 1, 1952

### ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 66,900,000 lb. on November 1, 1952, of which 63,448,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 3,452,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 1,730,000 lb. frozen fresh and 150,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 714,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 141,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at October 1, 1952. Compared with November 1, 1951 figures, they are higher by 5,854,000 lb. frozen fresh and by 559,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 573,000 pounds as compared with a similar movement of 6.7 million pounds during October, 1951.

### SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen Cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 11,946,000 lb., consisting of 10,340,000 lb. frozen fresh and 1,606,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during October was 642,000 pounds as compared with a similar movement of 200,000 pounds during October, 1951. The quantity reported as having been frozen during October was 2,627,000 lb., but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

### HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen Haddock, not including estimates for late firms, totalled 1,699,000 lb. of which 1,416,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 283,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 313,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year and 336,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 533,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during October, 1952.

### SALMON

Frozen Salmon stocks at November 1, were 12,070,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 16,512,000 lb. last year and 10,465,000 lb. last month. The apparent net increase during October was 1.6 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 5.7 million pounds during the same month of 1951. Freezings during October were 2,161,000 lb.

### SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring including kippers were reported as being 9,625,000 lb. of which 8,349,000 lb. were fresh and 1,276,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 7,395,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 1.7 million pounds over last month's total. The quantity frozen during October was 277,000 lb.

### OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 20,765,000 lb., being reported as frozen fresh 20,658,000 lb., and frozen smoked 107,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during October totalled 4,831,000 lb.

### INLAND FISH

There were on hand 8,915,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh. There were 513,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during the month of October, 1952.
