COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - APRIL 1, 1952

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 27,812,000 lb. on April 1, 1952, of which 25,960,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 1,852,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 710,000 lb. frozen fresh and 120,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are lower by 5,556,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 295,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at March 1, 1952. Compared with April 1, 1951, figures they are higher by 2,686,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 231,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "out-of-storage" movement for all classifications of 5.3 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 6.2 million pounds during March, 1951.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 3,866,000 lb., consisting of 2,823,000 lb. frozen fresh and 1,043,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net increase during March was 468,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 51,000 lb. during March, 1951. The quantity reported as having been frozen during March was 3,834,000 lb., but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock, not including estimates for late firms, totalled 1,474,000 lb. of which 1,216,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 258,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 25,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year, 720,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 2,099,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during March, 1952.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at April 1 were 6,652,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 5,043,000 lb. last year and 9,272,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during March was 2.6 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1.8 million lb. during the same month of 1951. Freezings during March were 99,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers, were reported as being 7,378,000 lb. of which 7,056,000 lb. were fresh and 322,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 7,423,000 lb. This month's figures show an increase of 923,000 lb. from last month's total. The quantity frozen during March was 608,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 5,066,000 lb., being reported as frozen fresh, 5,011,000 lb. and frozen smoked, 55,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during March totalled 1,046,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 2,545,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 1,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 88,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during the month of March, 1952.
