



COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - MAY 1, 1952

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 29,537,000 lb. on MAY 1, 1952, of which 26,721,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 2,816,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 635,000 lb. frozen fresh and 250,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 1,155,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 1,020,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at APRIL 1, 1952. Compared with MAY 1, 1951, figures they are higher by 4,241,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 18,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 2.2 million pounds as compared with an opposite movement of 79 thousand pounds during APRIL, 1951.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen Cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 7,415,000 lb., consisting of 5,506,000 lb. frozen fresh and 1,909,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net increase during APRIL was 3.4 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 696,000 lb. during APRIL, 1951. The quantity reported as having been frozen during APRIL was 5,439,000 lb., but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen Haddock, not including estimates for late firms, totalled 1,873,000 lb. of which 1,617,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 256,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 45,000 lb. higher than the stocks on hand last year and 350,000 lb. higher than last month. There were 1,065,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during APRIL, 1952.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at MAY 1 were 5,730,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 4,049,000 lb. last year and 6,690,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during March was 960 thousand lb. as compared with a similar movement of 994 thousand lb. during the same month of 1951. Freezings during April were 90,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers, were reported as being 6,873,000 lb. of which 6,562,000 lb. were fresh and 311,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 8,056,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 541,000 lb. from last month's total. The quantity frozen during April was 2,225,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 4,219,000 lb., being reported as frozen fresh, 4,155,000 lb. and frozen smoked, 64,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during April totalled 945,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 2,541,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh and 1,000 lb. frozen smoked. There were 146,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during the month of April, 1952.
