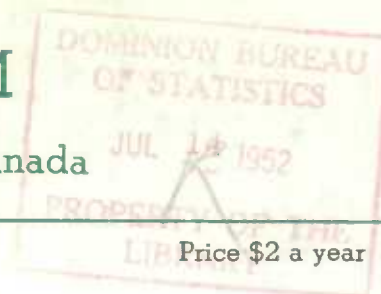

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - JULY 1, 1952

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 45,130,000 lb. on July 1, 1952, of which 41,934,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 3,196,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 1,305,000 lb. frozen fresh and 175,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 9,429,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 734,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at June 1, 1952. Compared with July 1, 1951 figures, they are higher by 4,280,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 87,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 10.2 million pounds as compared with similar movement of 3.1 million pounds during June, 1951.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen Cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 8,753,000 lb., consisting of 6,433,000 lb. frozen fresh and 2,320,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net increase during June was 1,529,000 pounds as compared with a similar movement of 622,000 lb. during June, 1951. The quantity reported as having been frozen during June was 4,345,000 lb., but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen Haddock, not including estimates for late firms, totalled 2,149,000 lb. of which 1,830,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 319,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 13,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year and 431,000 lb. higher than last month. There were 688,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during June, 1952.

SALMON

Frozen Salmon stocks at July 1, were 4,957,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 2,716,000 lb. last year and 4,391,000 lb. last month. The apparent net increase during June was 566,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 104,000 lb. during the same month of 1951. Freezings during June were 1,756,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers were reported as being 6,492,000 lb. of which 6,261,000 lb. were fresh and 231,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figure was 6,474,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 1,921,000 lb. over last month's total. The quantity frozen during June was 1,706,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 17,454,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh, 17,354,000 lb., and frozen smoked 100,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during June totalled 10,155,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 3,845,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh. There were 176,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during the month of June, 1952.
