

## COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - SEPTEMBER 1, 1952

### ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 61,029,000 lb. on September 1, 1952, of which 57,247,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 3,782,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 1,360,000 lb. frozen fresh and 70,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 4,931,000 lb. frozen fresh and higher by 648,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at August 1, 1952. Compared with September 1, 1951 figures, they are higher by 9,126,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 28,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 5.6 million pounds as compared with similar movement of 6.3 million pounds during August, 1951.

### SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen Cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 12,162,000 lb., consisting of 10,081,000 lb. frozen fresh and 2,081,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during August was 223,000 lb. as compared with an opposite movement of 1.4 million pounds during August, 1951. The quantity reported as having been frozen during August was 1,756,000 lb., but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

### HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen Haddock, not including estimates for late firms, totalled 2,065,000 lb. of which 1,779,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 286,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 316,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year and 88,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 286,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during August, 1952.

### SALMON

Frozen Salmon stocks at September 1, were 8,663,000 lb. without estimating for late firms, as compared with 7,578,000 lb. last year and 6,350,000 lb. last month. The apparent net increase during August was 2.3 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 3.0 million pounds during the same month of 1951. Freezings during August were 5,145,000 lb.

### SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers were reported as being 9,714,000 lb. of which 8,555,000 lb. were fresh and 1,159,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figures was 7,599,000 lb. This month's figures show an increase of 2.5 million pounds over last month's total. The quantity frozen during August was 4,758,000 lb.

### OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 20,878,000 lb. being reported as frozen fresh 20,767,000 lb., and frozen smoked 111,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during August totalled 3,136,000 lb.

### INLAND FISH

There were on hand 6,117,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fish. There were 524,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during the month of August, 1952.
