

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - NOVEMBER 1, 1953

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 60,515,000 lb. on November 1, 1953, of which 58,405,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 2,110,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 850,000 lb. frozen fresh and 145,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are higher by 883,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 136,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at October 1, 1953. Compared with November 1, 1952, figures they are lower by 5,631,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 1,424,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "into-storage" movement for all classifications of 747,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 536,000 lb. during October, 1952.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 6,177,000 lb., consisting of 5,463,000 lb. frozen fresh and 714,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during October was 836,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 72,000 lb. during October, 1952. The quantity reported as having been frozen during October was 2,961,000 lb., but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock, not including estimates for late firms, totalled 1,450,000 lb., of which 1,317,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 133,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 392,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year and 209,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 441,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during October, 1953.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at November 1 were 15,627,000 lb. without estimates for late firms as compared with 12,322,000 lb. last year and 10,602,000 lb. last month. The apparent net increase during October was 5.0 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1.7 million lb. during the same month of 1952. Freezings during October were 6,889,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers, were reported as being 8,587,000 lb., of which 7,797,000 lb. were fresh and 790,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 10,046,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 1.3 million pounds from last month's total. The quantity frozen during October was 75,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 22,291,000 lb., reported as frozen fresh 22,210,000 lb., and frozen smoked 81,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during October totalled 2,989,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 5,388,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh. There were 415,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during the month of October, 1953.
