



COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - JANUARY 1, 1954

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 51,336,000 lb. on January 1, 1954, of which 49,520,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 1,816,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 1,060,000 lb. frozen fresh and 40,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are lower by 5,952,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 96,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at December 1, 1953. Compared with January 1, 1953, figures they are lower by 2,178,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 1,267,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "out-of-storage" movement for all classifications of 6.0 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 5.9 million pounds during December, 1952.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 4,565,000 lb., consisting of 3,861,000 lb. frozen fresh and 704,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during December was 1.2 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 2.0 million pounds during December, 1952. The quantity reported as having been frozen during December was 1,527,000 lb., but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock, not including estimates for late firms, totalled 2,243,000 lb., of which 2,080,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 163,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 151,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year and 420,000 higher than last month. There were 1,408,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during December, 1953.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at January 1 were 11,694,000 lb. without estimates for late firms as compared with 10,488,000 lb. last year and 13,314,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during December was 1.6 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1.1 million lb. during the same month of 1952. Freezings during December were 60,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers, were reported as being 7,762,000 lb., of which 7,092,000 were fresh and 670,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 8,940,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 528,000 lb. from last month's total. The quantity frozen during December was 1,246,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 19,293,000 lb., reported as frozen fresh 19,247,000 lb., and frozen smoked 46,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during December totalled 1,373,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 4,679,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh. There were 64,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during the month of December, 1953.
