

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - MARCH 1, 1954

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 36,400,000 lb. on March 1, 1954, of which 34,851,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 1,549,000 lb. frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 910,000 lb. frozen fresh and 80,000 lb. frozen smoked are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are lower by 6,632,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 25,000 lb. frozen smoked than those at February 1, 1954. Compared with March 1, 1953 figures they are lower by 1,553,000 lb. frozen fresh and lower by 967,000 lb. frozen smoked. There was an "out-of-storage" movement for all classifications of 6.7 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 7.1 million pounds during February, 1953.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 3,839,000 lb., consisting of 3,049,000 lb. frozen fresh and 790,000 lb. frozen smoked. The apparent net decrease during February was 325,000 pounds as compared with a similar movement of 1.5 million pounds during February, 1953. The quantity reported as having been frozen during February was 3,606,000 lb., but no estimate is made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock, not including estimates for late firms, totalled 1,278,000 lb., of which 1,168,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 110,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 791,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year and 359,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 1,777,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during February, 1954.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at March 1 were 7,349,000 lb. without estimates for late firms as compared with 5,910,000 lb. last year and 10,225,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during February was 2.9 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 2.3 million lb. during the same month of 1953. Freezings during February were 87,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Frozen stocks of herring, including kippers, were reported as being 6,961,000 lb., of which 6,474,000 lb. were fresh and 487,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the combined figures were 8,911,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 549,000 lb. from last month's total. The quantity frozen during February was 410,000 lb.

OTHER SEAFISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 13,374,000 lb., reported as frozen fresh 13,328,000 lb., and frozen smoked 46,000 lb. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during February totalled 996,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 2,609,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh. There were 115,000 lb. of inland fish frozen during the month of February, 1954.
