

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - MAY 1, 1954

ALL FISH

Stocks of all frozen fish in Canada amounted to 26,488,000 pounds on May 1, 1954, of which 23,940,000 pounds were frozen fresh and 2,548,000 pounds frozen smoked. In these figures estimates of 226,000 pounds frozen fresh are included for firms failing to report on time. These holdings are lower by 2,031,000 pounds frozen fresh and higher by 368,000 pounds frozen smoked than those at April 1, 1954. Compared with May 1, 1953, figures they are lower by 8,620,000 pounds frozen fresh and lower by 7,000 pounds frozen smoked. There was an "out-of-storage" movement for all classifications of 1.7 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 0.8 million pounds during April, 1953.

SEA FISH - COD

Stocks of frozen cod, not including estimates for late firms, were 5,563,000 lb., consisting of 3,791,000 lb. frozen fresh and 1,772,000 lb. frozen smoked. Apparent net increase during April was 1,669,000 lb. as compared with a similar movement of 526,000 lb. during April, 1953. The quantity reported as having been frozen during April was 4,336,000 lb., but no estimates are made for firms failing to report on time.

HADDOCK

Stocks of frozen haddock, not including estimates for late firms, totalled 3,190,000 lb., of which 2,934,000 lb. were frozen fresh and 256,000 lb. frozen smoked. Haddock holdings were 461,000 lb. lower than the stocks on hand last year, and 266,000 lb. lower than last month. There were 2,604,000 lb. reported as having been frozen during April, 1954.

SALMON

Frozen salmon stocks at May 1 were 3,364,000 lb., without estimates for late firms, as compared with 3,019,000 lb. last year and 4,659,000 lb. last month. The apparent net decrease during April was 1.3 million lb. as compared with a similar movement of 1.3 million lb. during the same month of 1953. Freezings during April were 22,000 lb.

SEA HERRING

Stocks of frozen herring, including kippers, were reported as being 5,601,000 lb., of which 5,203,000 lb. were fresh and 398,000 lb. smoked. Last year at the same date the total was 8,735,000 lb. This month's figures show a decrease of 17,000 lb. from last month's amount. The quantity frozen during April was 869,000 lb.

OTHER SEA FISH

Other frozen stocks amounted to 4,155,000 lb., reported as 4,086,000 lb. frozen fresh, and 69,000 lb. frozen smoked. All other sea fish reported as having been frozen during April totalled 1,703,000 lb.

INLAND FISH

There were on hand 1,656,000 lb. of inland fish frozen fresh, and 262,000 lb. were frozen during the month of April, 1954.
