



INTRODUCTION

Beginning with the February issue of this publication, our coverage of establishments freezing fish and storing frozen fishery products was revised. This was a result of a survey made in 1955 on the Cold Storage Facilities for fish and of a subsequent analysis of special reports obtained in 1956. A number of establishments storing small amounts of fish were eliminated from our reporting list, whenever the amounts involved from month to month did not significantly alter the provincial or regional picture. On the other hand some establishments not previously reporting were added, resulting in a net increase in the number incorporated into this report.

Figures of stocks in this publication (Table 1) refer to the same establishments in both years and are therefore comparable. Reference to figures previously published for 1956 will indicate that our volume coverage was increased. We attempt to cover approximately ninety-eight per cent of the Canadian totals and about ninety-five per cent or more within each province or area.

Cumulative freezings (Table 2) are not strictly comparable, because the January figures incorporated into the totals could not be revised for 1956.

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - NOVEMBER 30, 1957

The total reported stocks of frozen fishery products were 63.7 million pounds at the end of November, a decline of 23 per cent compared with 1956. Bait, cod fillets, Pacific salmon and halibut were the main products contributing to the decrease.

The freezings of fishery products were 17 per cent greater than those of November 1956, but the cumulative figures for the period January-November were 1 per cent below those of a year ago. A significant decline was recorded for the Pacific salmon products, compared with 1956.

Stocks of Fresh-Frozen Sea Fish -

The stocks of fresh-frozen sea fish declined by 19 per cent to 41.0 million pounds from 50.8 million in the preceding year. Those of groundfish fillets were down by 27 per cent to 16.4 million pounds from 22.4 million, cod fillets and blocks contributing mostly to the decrease. The stocks of Pacific halibut and salmon were also substantially below those of a year ago.

The holdings of fresh-frozen sea fish dropped substantially in British Columbia, Newfoundland and Quebec, but remained at about the same level in the Maritime Provinces.

Stocks of the Freshwater species, Smoked Fish and Bait -

The stocks of the freshwater species, at 8.2 million pounds, were 11 per cent less than a year ago, perch being the main species held in smaller quantity. Those of the smoked products, at 2.6 million lb, were somewhat less than a year ago. Most significant was the drop in bait holdings by more than 50 per cent to 7.1 million pounds, from 14.6 million in 1956.

Freezings of Fishery Products -

The freezings of fish in November, reported at 10.6 million pounds, were 17 per cent over those of the same month of 1956. Those of groundfish fillets were up to 6.8 million pounds, from 5.6 million a year ago, cod packaged fillets and blocks contributing mostly to the increase.

Cumulative figures for the period January-November, at 216.7 million pounds were 1 per cent less than for the previous year. A substantial decline was shown in the freezings of Pacific salmon and bait; however this was partially offset by larger amounts of groundfish fillets, Pacific halibut and inland species frozen this year than last. The frozen groundfish fillet figure (including blocks) was 121.8 million pounds versus 117.3 million in 1956.

N.B. - This report is compiled from schedules submitted by 274 firms. Only two of these establishments have failed to report on time for November 1957.
