


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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH

FEBRUARY, 1957

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INTRODUCTION

Beginning with this issue, our coverage of establishments freezing fish and storing frozen fishery products is revised. This is a result of a survey made in 1955 on the Cold Storage Facilities for fish and of a subsequent analysis of special reports obtained in 1956. A number of establishments storing small amounts of fish were eliminated from our mailing list, whenever the amounts involved from month to month did not significantly alter the provincial or regional picture. On the other hand some establishments not previously reporting were added, resulting in a net increase in the number incorporated into this report.

Figures of stocks in this publication refer to the same establishments in both years and are therefore comparable. Reference to figures previously published for 1956 will indicate that our volume coverage was increased. We attempt to cover approximately ninety-eight per cent of the Canadian totals and about ninety-five per cent or more within each province or area.

Cumulative freezings appearing in Table 2 are not strictly comparable, because the January figures incorporated into the totals could not be revised for 1956.

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - FEBRUARY 28, 1957

The total reported stocks of frozen fish reached 57,725,000 lb. at the end of February and this was 21,023,000 lb. more than last year at the same date. The increase was most significant in the case of Pacific salmon and Halibut. Bait and animal feed inventories were also substantially higher than last year, while moderate increases materialized in the stocks of groundfish fillets and fresh-frozen inland species.

The freezings of fishery products in the month were 10,244,000 lb., 2,579,000 lb. less than the February 1956 figure. There was a net out-of-storage movement of 8,077,000 lb. during the month.

Fresh-Frozen Sea Fish -

The inventories of fresh-frozen sea fish reached 32,194,000 lb. at the end of February, 12,417,000 lb. above the 1956 level, at the same date. The stocks of dressed halibut originating from the West Coast increased to 6,412,000 lb., from 2,440,000 lb. a year ago; those of Pacific salmon were 7,309,000 lb. against 2,045,000 lb. in the preceding year. The inventories of fresh-frozen groundfish fillets (including the blocks) increased somewhat to 11,520,000 lb., from 10,029,000 lb. at the end of February 1956.

The net out-of-storage movement of fresh-frozen sea fish was 6,611,000 lb. within the past month, of which 2,807,000 lb. were groundfish fillets.

Inland Species and Smoked Fish -

The stocks of the fresh-frozen inland species increased from 3,297,000 lb. last year to 5,493,000 lb. in the current year, end of February. Perch, pike and saugers were the main species contributing to the increase.

The frozen-smoked fish stocks, at 1,826,000 lb., for the end of February, showed virtually no change from the previous year level. The stocks of bait and animal feed increased from 11,885,000 lb. at the end of February 1956 to 18,212,000 lb. this year.

Freezings of fish -

The freezings of fish during February were 10,244,000 lb., compared with 12,823,000 lb. within the same month of 1956. The decrease this year mainly applies to groundfish fillets of which 6,474,000 lb. were frozen, against 8,242,000 lb. in the same month of 1956.
