


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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH

MARCH, 1957

Memorandum



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INTRODUCTION

Beginning with the February issue of this publication, our coverage of establishments freezing fish and storing frozen fishery products was revised. This was a result of a survey made in 1955 on the Cold Storage Facilities for fish and of a subsequent analysis of special reports obtained in 1956. A number of establishments storing small amounts of fish were eliminated from our reporting list, whenever the amounts involved from month to month did not significantly alter the provincial or regional picture. On the other hand some establishments not previously reporting were added, resulting in a net increase in the number incorporated into this report.

Figures of stocks in this publication (Table 1) refer to the same establishments in both years and are therefore comparable. Reference to figures previously published for 1956 will indicate that our volume coverage was increased. We attempt to cover approximately ninety-eight per cent of the Canadian totals and about ninety-five per cent or more within each province or area.

Cumulative freezings (Table 2) are not strictly comparable, because the January figures incorporated into the totals could not be revised for 1956.

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH - MARCH 31, 1957

The total reported stocks of frozen fish reached 47.9 million lb. at the end of March and this was 14.7 million lb. or 80 per cent more than last year at the same date. However, this increase is substantially accounted for by heavier inventories of bait and animal foods. The stocks of edible fisheries products, at 29.2 million lb., were still 42 per cent more than a year ago, the Pacific salmon and halibut mainly contributing to the change.

The freezings of fishery products in March were 12.9 million lb., 1.6 million or 14 per cent more than the March 1956 figure. There was a net out-of-storage movement of almost 12 million lb., applying exclusively to the edible products.

Fresh-Frozen Sea Fish -

The inventories of fresh-frozen sea fish (excluding bait and animal foods) reached 23.0 million lb. at the end of March, 7.9 million lb. or 52.5 per cent above the 1956 level at the same date. The stocks of dressed halibut from the West Coast increased to 4.0 million lb., from 1.4 million a year ago; those of Pacific salmon were 5.6 million lb. against 1.4 million in the preceding year. The inventories of fresh-frozen groundfish fillets (including the blocks), at 8.4 million lb., were virtually unchanged from the past year level.

The net out-of-storage movement of fresh-frozen sea fish was 10.6 million lb. within the past month, of which 4.4 million lb. was groundfish fillets. These figures were substantially higher than for February and partly reflect the increased consumption of fish during lent.

Inland Species and Smoked Fish -

The stocks of fresh-frozen inland species increased from 2.9 million lb. last year to 4.1 million lb. in the current year, end of March. Perch and whitefish were the main species contributing to the increase.

The frozen-smoked stocks, at almost 2 million lb. for the end of March, were 0.4 million less than a year ago. The stocks of bait and animal foods increased by 47 per cent, from 12.7 million lb. at the end of March 1956 to 18.7 million lb. this year. The increase is largely accounted for by heavy bait inventories in Newfoundland and large animal food supplies in British Columbia.

Freezings of Fish -

The freezings of fish during March were 12.9 million lb., 14 per cent more than last year within the same month. The increase this year mainly applies to the groundfish fillets of which 9.0 million lb. were frozen during the month against 7.4 million lb. a year ago. More cod and sole fillets were frozen during March this year than last.

The cumulative freezings to end of March were 30.5 million lb. against 33.3 million lb. last year. The freezings of groundfish fillets declined from 21.7 million lb. to 17.7 million, the haddock production mainly contributing to the decrease.
