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

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CONTENTS

Starting with January 1958, the tables included in this report (previously "COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH") were recasted to give information on fish freezings on an area basis as well as for the whole country. It is noteworthy that Table 1, for Canada, refers to a greater number of products than the subsequent ones for the provinces or areas. It is therefore not always possible to obtain from the report all the figures accruing to product totals given in Table 1.

INVENTORIES CONTINUE TO BE HEAVIER THAN IN 1958

The total inventory of frozen fish at the end of March amounted to 37,037,000 pounds. This represents a decline of seven per cent since February at the same date but is 24 per cent higher than the 29,972,000 pounds held a year ago. There were 19,954,000 pounds of frozen sea fish in storage this year compared with 13,780,000 pounds at the end of March 1958 an increase of 45 per cent. However the supply declined since the end of February when 23,788,000 pounds were on hand. Stocks of fresh water fish were also greater than they were a year ago. The end of March inventories this year amounted to 4,330,000 pounds, up 55 per cent since 1958 at the same date.

Stocks of Frozen Fish by Products

The supply of frozen cod fillets (including blocks) increased 28 per cent since the end of February to 1,756,000 pounds. The present stocks are 50 per cent greater than at the end of March 1958 when 1,171,000 pounds were on hand. The holdings of frozen haddock fillets (including blocks) also increased substantially during the month and now amount to 3,555,000 pounds. This is an increase of 121 per cent since the end of February and 43 per cent more than the March 1958 inventory of 2,482,000 pounds. The March inventories of Pacific halibut were somewhat heavier than they were a year ago at 2,528,000 pounds. However there was a substantial drop since the end of February when 4,557,000 pounds were on hand. The supply of small flat fish fillets also declined during the month and holdings are currently set at 1,030,000 pounds. Pacific salmon continues to be in much heavier supply than in 1958 at the same date. The end of March inventories this year were 5,710,000 pounds compared with 2,431,000 pounds a year ago, an increase of 135 per cent. The disappearance since February amounted to 1,575,000 pounds.

Freezings of Fishery Products

The total freezings of fish during the month of March amounted to 10,887,000 pounds. This is 18 per cent below the 1958 level for the same month when 13,288,000 pounds were produced. Freezings since the beginning of the year amounted to 28,084,000 pounds a decline of 9 per cent since last year. There were 2,193,000 pounds of cod fillets (including blocks) produced this month which brings the output for the first three months of the year to 4,601,000 pounds. This is almost one-third less than was produced in the same period in 1958. Haddock fillet production (including blocks) is also substantially below the 1958 level. There were 3,798,000 pounds frozen this month compared with 6,157,000 pounds a year ago. Since January 1, 8,684,000 pounds have been frozen this year compared with 10,311,000 pounds in 1958. The output of frozen flat fish fillets this month was more than double that of a year ago at 789,000 pounds (334,000 pounds). However production since the beginning of the year is 12 per cent lighter.

N.B. - This report is compiled from schedules submitted by 250 firms. However two of these establishments failed to report on time for March 31, 1959.
