FISH FREEZINGS AND STOCKS

JULY 1960



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Starting with January 1958, the tables included in this report (previously "COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF FISH") were recasted to give information on fish freezings on an area basis as well as for the whole country. It is noteworthy that Table 1, for Canada, refers to a greater number of products than the subsequent ones for the provinces or areas. It is therefore not always possible to obtain from the report all the figures accruing to product totals given in Table 1.

FROZEN FISH, July 1960.

Inventories of frozen fish increased substantially since the end of June and stocks of both sea and fresh water fish now stand at 79,859,000 pounds. Current holdings are four per cent greater than the 77,158,000 pounds held on the same date a year ago. There were 38,114,000 pounds of fish and fish products frozen during the month compared with the 40,690,000 pounds during July 1959, a decrease of six per cent. For the first seven months of 1960, 145,183,000 pounds were produced.

Stocks of Frozen Fish, by Products

There were 58,357,000 pounds of frozen sea fish products held in storage on the last day of July 1960. This is 24 per cent higher than the June inventory of 47,011,000 pounds but only eight per cent greater than the 53,905,000 pounds held in storage at the end of July 1959. There were 22,529,000 pounds of frozen Atlantic Cod fillets (including blocks) on hand on the last day of July this year, compared with 15,477,000 pounds on the same date last year. This represents an increase of 46 per cent. At the end of June 1960 there were only 13,299,000 pounds in storage. July inventories of frozen haddock fillets (including blocks) declined 10 per cent since the end of June and now stand at 6,177,000 pounds. Stocks of Pacific halibut including dressed fish, fillets, and steaks show a four per cent increase over the 11,989,-000 pounds held in storage in June 1960 but are 15 per cent below the 1959 July holdings of 14,699,000 pounds. Supplies of small flatfish fillets including all flounders and soles at 4,001,000 pounds increased only two per cent since last month but were more than twice the 1,885,000 pounds on hand the end of July 1959. Pacific salmon supplies are double the amount of a month ago but are well below the 1959 level of the same date. There were 345,000 pounds on hand on July 31 this year compared with 1,735,000 pounds last month. Stocks of fresh water fish were also below the 1959 level at the end of July at 3,921,000 pounds. However, there was a 20 per cent increase since last month when 3,254,000 pounds were in storage.

Freezings of Fishery Products

Production of frozen sea fish products during July amounted to 30,786,000 pounds and brings the total for the first seven months of the year to 108,798,000. July freezings are 13 per cent below the 1959 level of 35,556,000 pounds but the total for January to July is six per cent less than that of the same period last year. The output in July this year of Atlantic Cod fillets (including blocks) was 17 per cent less than that of a year ago and amounted to 17,327,000 pounds. Since January 42,291,000 pounds have been frozen this year compared with the 43,297,000 pounds a year ago. In July haddock fillets (including blocks) at 1,035,000 pounds show a 14 per cent increase over the 909,000 pounds produced last year. The output for the year however is only 14,851,000 pounds or 28 per cent below last year's output. July freezings of Pacific halibut remained at about the same level as those of 1959 being only nine per cent lower than the 3,620,000 pounds frozen in the same month last year. The total for the year is also lower, now standing at 15,165,000 pounds. Production of fillets of flounders and soles during July amounted to 2,008,000 pounds or 23 per cent less than the 1959 total of 2,591,000 pounds. The 1960 output to date stands at 12,210,000 pounds compared with the 9,139,000 pounds of last year. Freezings of Pacific salmon were 43 per cent heavier for the month of July than they were a year ago at 2,176,000 pounds. The total for the year now amounts to 4,650,000 pounds (3,971,000 pounds).
