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

SEPTEMBER 1962

FROZEN FISH, SEPTEMBER 1962

Stocks of frozen fish, in total, increased six per cent since the end of August and now stand at 88,428,000 pounds. The end-of-September holdings this year are practically the same as they were a year ago when 88,501,000 pounds were on hand. Of the total inventory at the end of September this year, 61,683,000 pounds were sea fish. This is two per cent more than the August stocks of 60,205,000 pounds and seven per cent above the September level a year ago. Holdings of inland species this month at 7,808,000 pounds are 11 per cent greater than they were a month ago but are two per cent below the 7,963,000 pounds held last year. Total freezings during the past month at 28,009,000 pounds were four per cent lighter than they were for September 1961. Since January, however, production has increased 11 per cent and now stands at 244,535,000 pounds compared with 219,570,000 pounds. There were 20,826,000 pounds of sea fish frozen during September which brings the total for the year to date to 184,626,000 pounds. Comparable figures for 1961 were 19,585,000 pounds and 161,-638,000 pounds respectively. September production of frozen inland fish at 2,514,000 pounds was 20 per cent above the 1961 level and brings the output since January to 10,751,000 pounds.

Stocks of Frozen Fish, by Products - There were 24,458,000 pounds of Atlantic cod fillets (including blocks) in storage at the end of September this year. This represents a three per cent increase since the end of August when 23,662,000 pounds were on hand. Current inventories are 36 per cent greater than the 18,021,000 pounds held in September 30 a year ago. Holdings of haddock fillets (including blocks) at the end of September this year were 12 per cent lighter than those of a month ago when 2,385,000 pounds were in storage. The present inventories are 47 per cent below the 1961 level. There was very little change in the stocks of Pacific halibut since last month. They now stand at 12,319,000 pounds which is one per cent above the August level. Holdings of flounder and sole fillets (including blocks) also increased since August from 3,104,000 to 3,469,000 pounds. The September inventory this year however, is 25 per cent lighter than that of a year ago when 4,636,000 pounds were in storage. Stocks of Pacific salmon remain practically unchanged since August at 8,245,000 pounds. This is five per cent above the 1961 level for the same date.

Freezings of Fishery Products - Freezings of Atlantic cod fillets (including blocks) at 8,917,000 pounds were three per cent lighter this month than they were in September a year ago. The output for the year now stands at 75,478,000 pounds which represents an increase of 21 per cent over that of a year ago for the same period. Freezings of haddock fillets (including blocks) during September amounted to 653,000 pounds. This is five per cent less than the 684,000 pounds frozen last year and brings the output since January to 24,892,000 pounds. September freezings of Pacific halibut are up sharply since last year and amounted to 1,561,000 pounds. The total for the year to date at 19,358,000 pounds, however, is still below the 1961 level of 20,605,000 pounds. Production of frozen flounder and sole fillets (including blocks), during the past month at 2,304,000 pounds was 18 per cent greater than that of September a year ago which brings freezings since January to 16,508,000 pounds. Frozen Pacific salmon production during September this year amounted to 2,399,000 pounds. This is 13 per cent more than was produced during the same month a year ago. The nine-months output for both years was 13,236,000 pounds and 10,330,000 pounds respectively.
