PULPWOOD AND WOOD RESIDUE STATISTICS

SEPTEMBER 1967

The data presented for pulpwood and wood residue are compiled from information supplied by domestic pulp and paper mills. Pulpwood for export is not included.

Purchased pulpwood is considered to have been produced in the month in which it was received.

Export and Import data as reported in Trade of Canada are shown in Tables 5 and 6, Page 4.
