PULPWOOD AND WOOD RESIDUE STATISTICS

FEBRUARY 1964

The information contained herein on pulpwood and wood residue is based on returns received from the users of these materials for the manufacture of pulp, paper and paperboard. In addition pulpwood production and pulpwood inventories includes data collected from exporters of pulpwood reporting to the Department of Trade and Commerce.

In Eastern Canada, the wood-year for reporting companies begins June 1 and at the request of the Canadian Pulp and Paper Association cumulative figures for their wood-year as well as the calendar year are provided. Inventory figures for pulpwood (Table 3) include wood on land and in water storage (roadside, block pile, rivers, lakes, etc.).
