## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON CCAL PRCDUCTICN

Coal production during January amounted to $1,660,000$ tons. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed an increase of 14.5 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 721,367 tons. This was an increase of 22.4 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Data on coal exported during January are not yet available. There were 27,815 tons exported during January, 1955.
