PROPERTY OF THE

PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during November amounted to 1,546,000 tons, making a total production of 13,336,639 tons for the first eleven months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 12.6 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 2,270,074 tons, making a total of 21,931,367 tons imported during the first eleven months of this year. This was an increase of 12.2 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during November amounted to 31,288 tons, as compared with 63,421 tons exported in November, 1955.
