PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during December amounted to 1,497,000 tons making a total production of 14,848,343 tons for the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 13.4 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 1,185,433 tons, making a total of 23,120,300 tons imported during the year. This was an increase of 1.5 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during December amounted to 34,498 tons, as compared with 37,783 tons exported in December, 1955.
