PROPERTY OF THE

PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during February amounted to 1,420,000 tons making a total production of 3,086,773 tons for the first two months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed an increase of 11.2 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 733,783 tons, making a total of 1,459,188 tons imported during the first two months of this year. This was an increase of 21.2 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Data on coal exported during February are not yet available. There were 17,946 tons exported in February, 1955.
