PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during March amounted to 1,300,000 tons making a total production of 4,387,489 tons for the first three months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 7.2 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 743,994 tons, making a total of 2,203,182 tons imported during the first three months of this year. This was an increase of 29.6 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during March amounted to 30,968 tons, as compared with 72,222 tons exported in March, 1955.
