PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

PROPERTY OF THE

Coal production during April amounted to 1,086,000 tons making a total production of 5,493,121 tons for the first four months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed an increase of 14.7 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 1,928,168 tons, making a total of 4,131,350 tons imported during the first four months of this year. This was an increase of 2.7 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during April amounted to 45,983 tons, as compared with 51,288 tons exported in April, 1955.
