PROPINTY OF THE

PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during September amounted to 1,142,000 tons making a total production of 10,299,656 tons for the first nine months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 9.2 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 2,421,789 tons, making a total of 17,126,002 tons imported during the first nine months of this year. This was an increase of 15.4 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during September amounted to 16.151 tons, as compared with 100,317 tens exported in September, 1955.
