## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during August amounted to 743,000 tons making a total production of 7,911,048 tons for the first eight months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 13.2 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 2,464,809 tons, making a total of 13,807,750 tons imported during the first eight months of this year. This was a decrease of 16.5 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Data on coal exported during August are not yet available. There were 24,063 tons exported in August, 1956.
