Coal production during October amounted to 1,240,000 tons, making a total production of 9,051,165 tons for the first ten months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 17.2 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 1,678,085 tons, making a total of 11,279,601 tons imported during the first ten months of this year. This was a decrease of 15.6 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Data on coal exported during October are not yet available. These were 44,638 tons exported during October, 1957.
