## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during November amounted to 1,180,000 tons making a total production of 10,490,072 tons for the first eleven months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 12.9 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 1,489,897 tons, making a total of 12,769,498 tons imported during the first eleven months of this year. This was an increase of 1.8 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Data on coal exported during November are not yet available. There were 50,605 tons exported in November, 1957.
