## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during February amounted to 1,180,000 tons making a total production of 2,455,675 tons for the first two months of the year. In communison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 10.8 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 291,396 tons, making a total of 701,433 tons imported during the first two months of this year. This was a decrease of 46.8 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during February amounted to 28,871 tons, as compared with 32,512 tons exported in February, 1957.
