PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

PROPERTY OF THE

Coal production during March amounted to 933,000 tens making a total production of 3,388,675 tens for the first three months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decresse of 13 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 300,094 tons, making a total of 1,001,527 tons imported during the first three months of this year. This was a decrease of 51.8 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Coal exported during March amounted to 25,993 tons, as compared with 38,859 tons exported in March, 1957.
