

PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

Coal production during June amounted to 692,000 tons making a total production of 5,777,391 tons for the first six months of the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 12.7 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 1,353,247 tons, making a total of 4.220.843 tons imported during the first six months of this year. This was a decrease of 50.1 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Data on coal exported during June are not yet available. There were 21,736 tons BRARY exported in June, 1957.
