## PRELIMINARY REPORT ON COAL PRODUCTION

December, 1959

Coal production during December amounted to 1,106,000 tons making a total production of 10,554,803 tons for the year. In comparison with the corresponding month of last year, production showed a decrease of 19.7 per cent.

Landed imports of coal during the month amounted to 453,537 tons, making a total of 13,629,471 tons imported during the year. This was a decrease of 23.4 per cent compared with the tonnage imported in the corresponding month of last year.

Data on coal exported during December are not yet available. There were 31,046 tons exported in December 1958.
